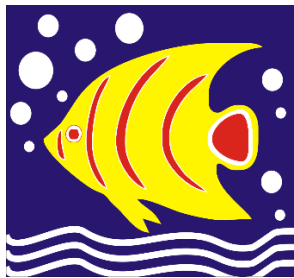
TOPIC: MOTIF CREATION

Motif can be defined as a unit of a design. It is a fraction of a whole design in textile design which can be seen in finished products like fabric design, Wallpaper, Carpet design and other related concept. A motif when repeated will produce what is known as pattern

TYPES / SOURCES OF MOTIF

Sources and types can be used in place of each other. These refer to the origin and classification of motif. The following have been identified as sources of motif

- (a) **Animal Motif:** These are motifs derived from forms, skin design and figures of animals.



- (b) **Floral Motif:** Floral motif is the means of creating design(s) from plants and vegetation. When a drawing and painting is made from structure and design in flower, Trees, and other forms that suggest growth.



- (c) **Geometric Motif:** This is the method of creating design(s) from basic and non basic shapes.



- (d) **Abstract Motif:** Abstract motif is the usage of non specific form, shape and concept to create a design.

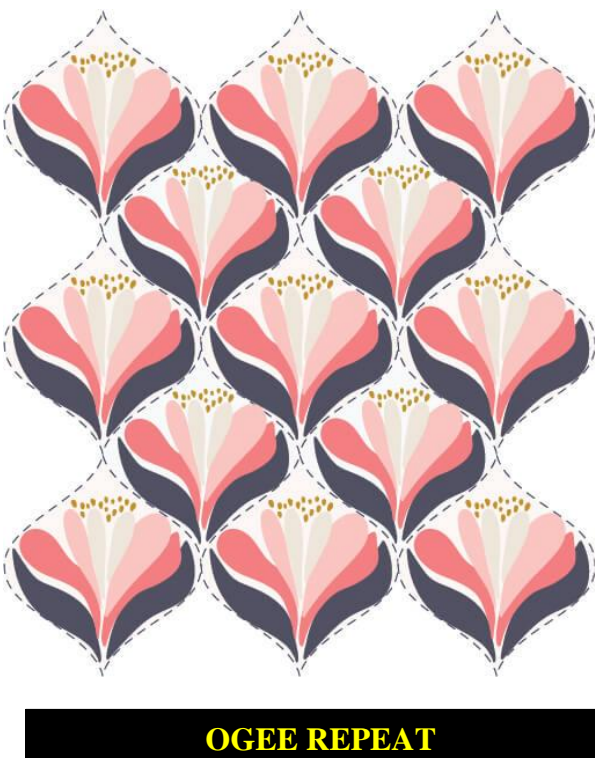
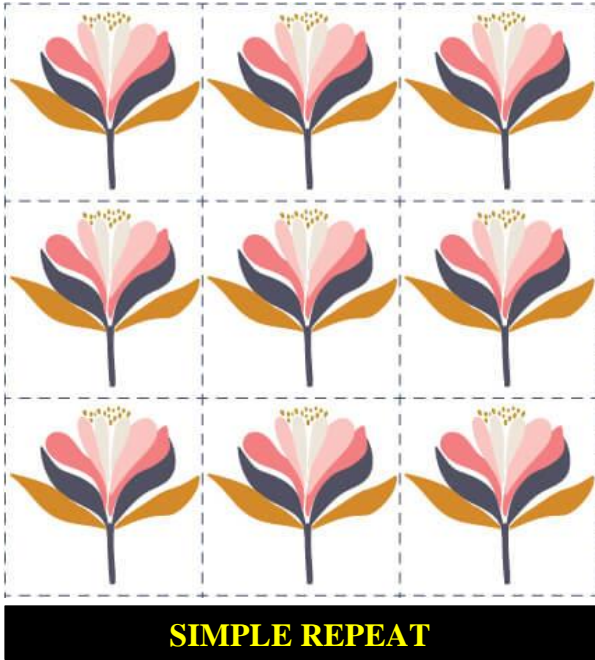


PATTERN CREATION

3. Ogee repeat pattern
4. Diamond repeat pattern
5. Half drop repeat pattern
